- EMT-Paramedic Certificate → Diploma
- □ Primary Care Paramedic (PCP) Bridge
- Intermediate Care Paramedic (ICP) Bridge
- □ Advanced Care Paramedic (ACP) Bridge


- □ Fall 2001








#### Photo of EHC Team Arrival at Whitehorse Airport
