

Developments in Chinese Education

- World population will increase by 50% over next 40 years
- Global movement of people will increase nine fold
- Currently total Chinese students at all levels 260 million
- Total enrolment in vocational education students is 23 million
- Total enrolment of higher education students is 23 million
- Chinese studying abroad total 933,000
- International students studying in China was 500,000 in 2004

- Edit and publication of China Graduates magazine



- What is HEQC?
- Higher Education Qualification Certificates (HEQCs)
 - > HEQC System was setup in 1950
 - Degree System was setup in 1981
 - HEQC is also known as HE 'Diploma' or Certificate of Graduation
 - Are state-recognised evidence of higher education experiences
 - HEQC level refers to a person's experiences of formal higher educational training
 - √ Post Secondary Level (zhuan Ke)
 - √ Undergraduate Degree Level (Ben Ke)
 - Postgraduate Degree Level,
 e.g. HEQC for Master degree or Doctoral Degree Level




- The Electronic Registration System of HEQC
- The certificates are verified and filed by MOE according to the recruitment data
- All state-recognised HEQCs awarded in and after 2001 must be electronically registered. Those that have not been registered electronically will not be recognised by the MOE
- The <u>www.chsi.com.cn</u> was authorised by MOE as the sole website on which inquiries regarding the HEQC can be made

Annual Distribution Chart of HEQC in China




- The only database containing all information relating to all HEQC's issued in China since 1991
- 38,486,000 records to date and around 6,000,000 records have been added annually in recent years
- Since 2002 the registered diplomas include graduation photographs

VETASSESS Qualifications Assessment and Verification Service

- Assessing authority designated by Australian Department of Immigration and Multicultural Affairs (DIMA) to assess over 240 occupations
- Assess for management, administration, professional and paraprofessional occupations
- Most need to be comparable to diploma or degrees on the AQF
- Assess qualifications awarded from over 115 countries
- Assessed over 70,000 international qualifications, including over 9,000 Chinese qualifications in last seven years

VETASSESS and Chinese Qualifications Verification Service

- Agreements with MOE China appointed authorities
 - CDGDC (verify degree qualifications)
 - CHESICC (verify non-degree qualifications)
- First authorised agent outside of China
- Authorised to promote Verification System to other English speaking countries
- Verified about 10,000 academic documents since July 2005
- Among them, about 5% documents have been verified as negative



VETASSESS and Chinese Qualifications Verification Service

- Who can apply for Verification?
- Individuals qualification holders
- Agents or organisations
 - Other assessing authorities e.g. CPA
 - Universities
 - authorised by qualification holder


What do we verify?

- All post-secondary qualifications awarded in the People's Republic of China from 1981 onwards, including
 - Degree Certificates
 - Higher Education Certificates of Graduation including study through regular, radio and TV, distance/internet learning, self-taught, in-service programmes
 - Academic transcripts of higher education & vocational programmes



- Primary or secondary school level qualifications
- Non-formal or incomplete higher education qualifications
- Joint-venture programmes which are not recognised by MOE China






